

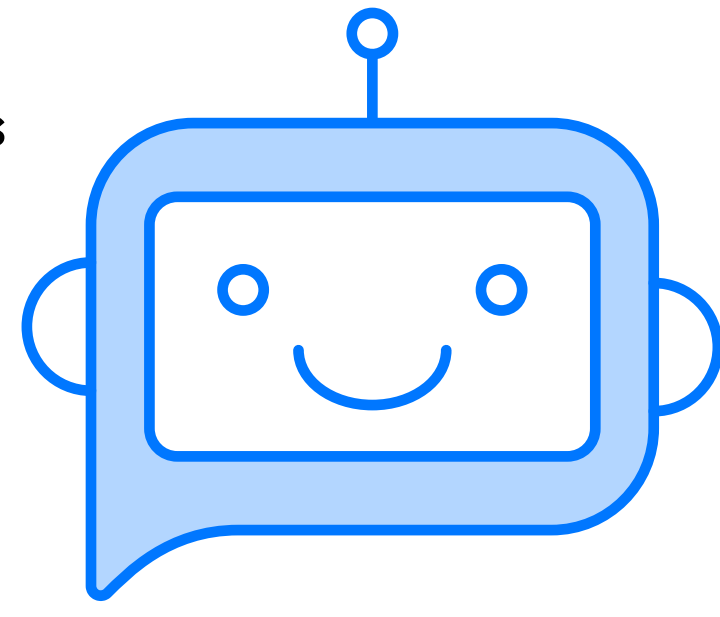


CHILD WELL-BEING

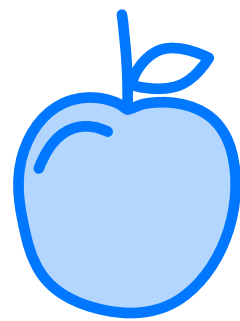
Promoted FAFSA* completion among educators, businesses and students and families through toolkits and two awareness campaigns.

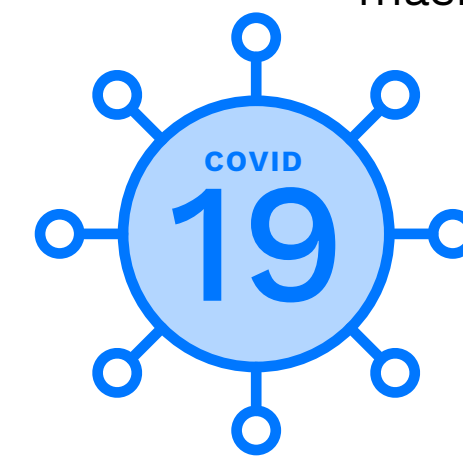
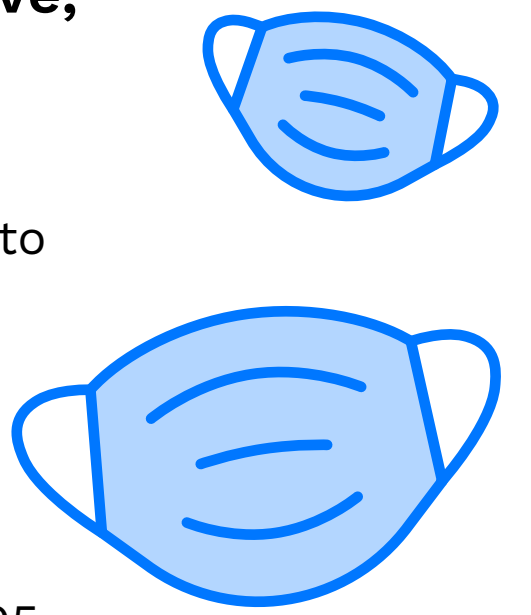
COVID-19 RESPONSE

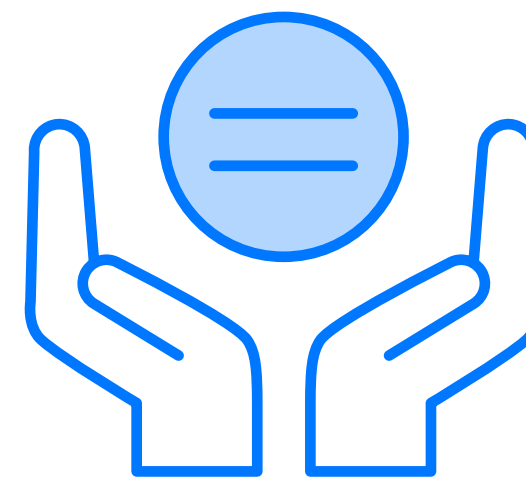

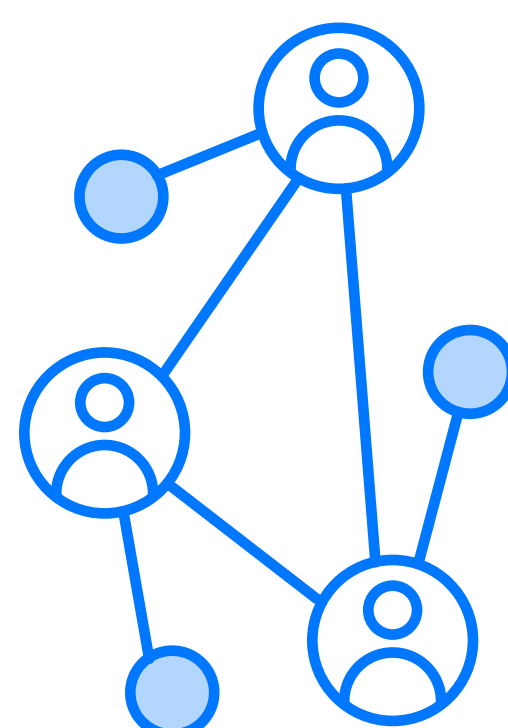


RACIAL JUSTICE

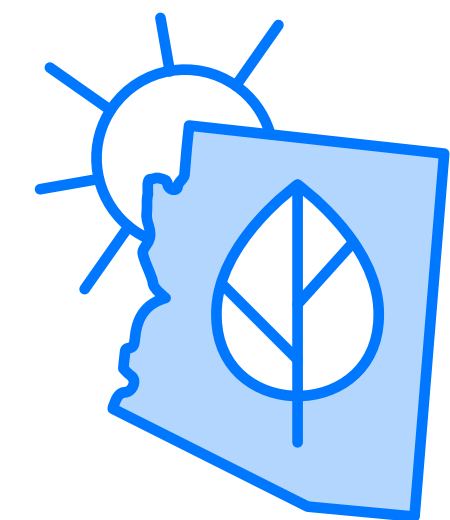

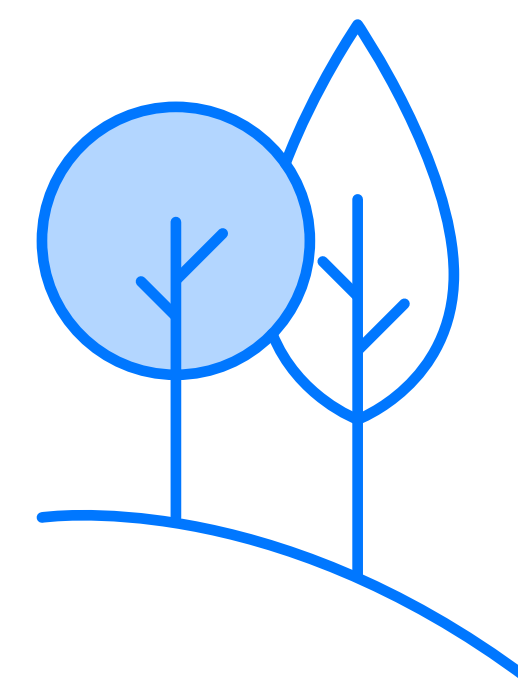
